Scholarship Chair

Each year, the Parents' Club offers full-tuition scholarships to two students who are selected by the Financial Aid Office. The Parents' Club has a scholarship endowment fund which is managed by Stanford University. The interest generated by the endowment fund currently allows the Parents' Club to provide two scholarships for two undergraduates.

The University makes all decisions as to student eligibility and award recipients. The club's President and VP of Student Support are the primary liaisons with the Office of Financial Aid/Department of Development Donor Relations.

In addition to our scholarships, the Scholarship Chair will arrange through the club's Birthday Treats Chair to send our scholarship students a free order of baked goods via our Birthday Treats program and will also offer to treat the students to a lunch or coffee during the year.

The Scholarship Chair may also invite the student recipients to introduce themselves to the club at a general meeting if they are amenable or encourage the students to write a message (anonymously, if desired) that we can share with our members.

The VP of Student Support oversees this program and will assist along the way as needed.
